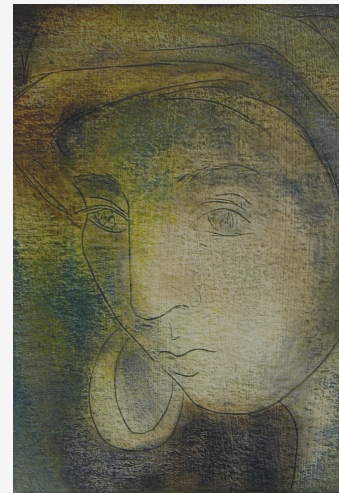


February/March, 2016

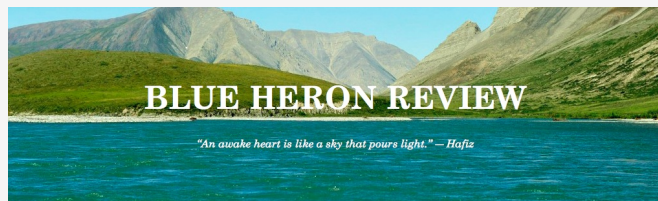

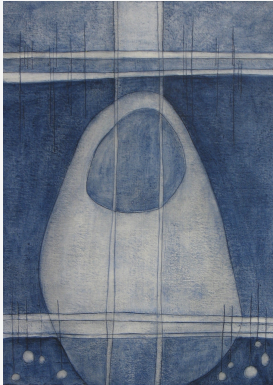

Come to the opening and enjoy a beautiful view of Lake Champlain at sunset. I will be reading poems from the book at 6pm.

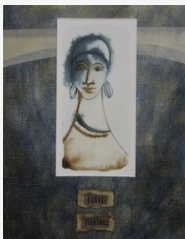
